Company looking to fill technician and call center positions

EVANSVILLE, IND., FEB. 23, 2015 — [AT&T](#)* today announced that it will hire workers for about 40 new jobs in Evansville. The positions to be filled are for technician roles and in the local call center.

AT&T invested nearly \$1.75 billion in its Indiana wireless and wireline networks between 2011 and 2013. The network investment is part of AT&T's Project Velocity IP (VIP), a three-year investment plan announced in fall 2012 to expand and enhance its IP broadband networks.

Last year, the company hired a total of 740 people in Indiana – nearly 300 of whom filled jobs in Evansville.
